Important Announcements

• Are you Real ID Ready?

The deadline to obtain a REAL ID is May 7, 2025, and applies to Fort Bragg visitors beginning May 8, 2025. Compliance with federal and state law is a vital component of our security framework, and essential to maintaining the safety of all who work, live or visit Fort Bragg.

TSA Discontinues Use of DoD Credentials:

Effective May 7, 2025, the Transportation Security Administration will no longer accept Department of Defense ID credentials at security checkpoints. DoD ID cardholders should be aware that this change may impact their air travel.

When this restriction takes effect, TSA will only accept the Common Access Card for identity verification. Identity verification is crucial to TSA's security model, as it helps determine passenger risk and appropriate screening measures.
