## **Command Sergeant Major**

Command Sgt. Maj. Jeffrey M. Bochey is the command sergeant major at the U.S. Army John F. Kennedy Special Warfare Center and School, Special Operations Center of Excellence, at Fort Bragg, North Carolina.

He is a native of Wilmington, North Carolina, and enlisted in the U.S. Army in September 2000. He completed One Station Unit Training and became a combat engineer in December 2000. He was then assigned to the 562nd Engineers in Fort Wainwright and Fort Richardson, Alaska.



Command Sgt. Maj. Bochey attended Special Forces Assessment and Selection in 2003 and went on to complete the Special Forces Qualification Course, where he was awarded the 18E military occupational specialty,

Special Forces communications sergeant, in 2005. He was then assigned to Alpha

Company, 2nd Battalion, 3rd Special Forces Group (Airborne).

His key assignments include combat engineer team member; Special Forces communications sergeant; S6 noncommissioned officer in charge; Special Forces intelligence sergeant, team sergeant; company first sergeant (Mission Support Element - Fort Bragg and Special Operations Joint Task Force-Afghanistan); 3rd Battalion, 3rd Special Forces Group company sergeant major; 1st Special Forces Group (Airborne); G3 sergeant major; command sergeant major at 1st Battalion, 3rd Special Forces Group (Airborne); command sergeant major at 1st Special Warfare Training Group (Airborne); and the U.S. Army Special Operations Command's Commander's Action Group senior enlisted leader.

Throughout his career as a Special Forces Soldier, Command Sgt. Maj. Bochey deployed several times in support of Operation Enduring Freedom, Operation Resolute Support, Operation Freedom Sentry, and Operation Juniper Shield.

His military education and training include the Summit Course, Joint Special Operations Forces Senior Enlisted Academy, Special Forces Qualification Course, Special Forces Intelligence Sergeant's Course, Basic Military Free Fall Course, Military Free Fall Jumpmaster, Basic Airborne Course, Static Line Jumpmaster, Survival-Evasion-Resistance and Escape Course, Air Assault Course, Senior Leader Course, Basic Non-Commissioned Officer's Course, Basic Leader's Course, and the Engineer Basic Course.
