Col. Kunzmann's other key assignments include deputy head SOF-cell Ministry of Defense, section head Joint Command Special Operations and deputy branch head central affairs Army Headquarters.

Col. Kunzmann is a graduate of the General Staff Course of the Joint Forces in Hamburg. He holds a Master of Mechanical Engineering from the University of the Bundeswehr in Munich and a Master of Operational Studies (SAW) from the Marine Corps University in Quantico, VA.
